All eyes will be on you when you step out in the Italian model.

This is the company's first foray into bicycle manufacturing, and the second version of the bike. If anything, Rizzoma - whose tagline proudly states "refuse the usual" - has succeeded in delivering an aesthetically stunning and well-engineered product. For starters, it lacks a seat tube. "double-diamond" frame design - it lacks a seat tube. Instead of the usual shape, the 77/011 looks like a trapezium. This isn't the first bike designed without a seat tube.
